4. Beginning Monday, September 14th, you will be able to log in again and rank the FLOs you are considering. You will be matched to the FLO ranked highest that chooses you for membership.

You may however, apply to as many as you would like. The twelve Freshmen Organizations are: Aggie Fish Club (AFC), Aggie Leaders of Tomorrow (ALOT), Aggies Selflessly Serving in Shaping Tomorrow (ASSIST), Freshmen Aggies Spreading Tradition (FAST), Fish Aides, Fish Council, Freshmen Leaders in Progress (FLIP), Freshmen in Service and Hosting (FISH), Freshmen Leaders In Christ (FLIC), and Leaders in Freshman Engineering (LIFE), Freshmen Leadership Experience(FLE) and Freshmen Liberal Arts Reaching Excellence(FLARE), Freshmen Leaders International (FLI), and Progressively Reaching Excellence in Professionalism (PREP).

After your last interview for a freshmen organization, you will be asked to rank all of the organizations for which you interviewed with according to your preference. In the event that you are selected for more than one freshmen organization, we will refer to your rankings and place you according to your preference.
